

We are dedicated to the Boneza, Rwanda community. In Rwanda, we believe that the most effective way to build sustainability and prosperity is to focus holistically on individual communities through education, clean water, healthcare, Pastoral care, and community development.



Since 2011, we've focused our efforts and resources on the community of Boneza in the Western Province of Rwanda. Located on the shores of Lake Kivu, the local population is approximately 30,000. Boneza's villagers are primarily agrarian, tending their personal gardens for their family food as well as larger plots of tea, coffee, bananas, and potatoes for trade.

This beautiful region is rich in human resources but underdeveloped in the areas of education, clean water, economic development, and essential infrastructure. Greetings From The Hills of Boneza, Rwanda!

Arise Rwanda Ministries continues to transform lives in the Boneza community through five ministry programs. As we reflect on 2022, we feel overwhelmed with blessings as it was an incredible year filled with God's miracles.

God has miraculously grown our education programs for students and members of the community. For starters, our school programs have expanded dramatically. The preschool program was our first initiative over a decade ago, started under a coffee tree with 60 children and a humble feeding program. Today, we're blessed to educate over 300 children across 6 preschools and 260 students at Kivu Hills Academy (KHA), our local high school. We also provide local Pastoral training as well as financial education to over 3,000 women in our micro-finance program where they can access small loans to start small, local businesses. Additionally, 2022 blessed us with tremendous progress on the construction of the Kivu Hills Medical Center (KHMC). We expect the KHMC to open this year and it will be the first hospital in the region, serving millions of people with affordable and quality healthcare services throughout the Western Province.

Through all of these blessings, we thank God, our team, the community, and YOU! We couldn't have done it without your generous partnership.

We gratefully reflect on the past year and look forward to continuously blessing the Boneza, Rwanda community. Thank you for your continued support to Arise Rwanda and the community of Boneza.

Greetings From The Board,

On behalf of the Arise Rwanda Ministries (ARM) Board, we are grateful to God for all the wonderful things He accomplished in 2022. It is exciting and humbling to be part of God's Kingdom work in Rwanda and live out the mission of providing clean water, education, economic development, Pastoral care, and healthcare to the community of Boneza.

In 2022, we made a commitment to add healthcare to our mission. While still supporting all areas of our mission, we spent much of last year focusing on Kivu Hills Medical Center(KHMC), a 50,000 square foot state-of-the-art medical hospital that will serve not only Boneza, but the entire region. KHMC will offer high-quality healthcare and provide medical services to these communities that have experience limited medical opportunities. We hope to have KHMC completed by the end of this year.

Over the past year, Rwanda has experienced over 30% inflation making basic items costly. ARM has been able to fill the gap in Boneza and help many families by providing additional food and steady jobs and income. We praise God for His faithfulness and provision through the generosity of His people!



2 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The 2023 economic development goal is to expand our micro-loan groups to include 5,000 women, resulting in 1,000 new small businesses. Currently 3,000 women participate in micro-loans groups.

Small Business Campaign

This campaign invests in local entrepreneurial women. Our micro-loan groups provide education around financial savings and empower women to create sustainable businesses in Boneza. Donations to this campaign help start small businesses through these local micro-loan groups. Examples of small local businesses women have started are fishing, sewing, small grocery stores and restaurants, and poultry farms.
